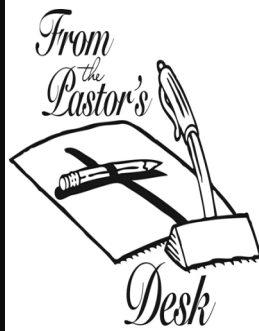

TOP SECRET RECIPE

Spaghetti Squash Alfredo

- 1 whole spaghetti squash about 3 pounds
 - 1/2 cup butter
 - 1 cup heavy cream
 - 1 clove garlic minced
 - 1/2 teaspoon cracked pepper
 - 1/4 teaspoon salt
 - 2 cups shredded Parmesan
 - 1 cup shredded mozzarella
- 1 teaspoon minced fresh parsley

Instructions:

1. Cut squash in half length-wise and scoop out the seeds and discard. Drizzle with olive oil and place face down on baking sheet. Bake for one hour until fork tender.
2. Shed the squash into spaghetti-like strands

Alfredo sauce:

1. Melt butter in sauce pan over medium heat.
2. Add the cream, garlic, salt and pepper and bring to a simmer.
3. Turn off the heat and add shredded Parmesan to the pan. Whisk until the cheese has melted and the sauce is smooth and creamy.

To Assemble:

1. Place squash in a 9x9 baking dish.
2. Pour sauce over the squash. Sprinkle with Mozzarella.
3. Bake at 350 degrees for 10 minutes
4. Sprinkle with parsley before serving.
5. Enjoy.

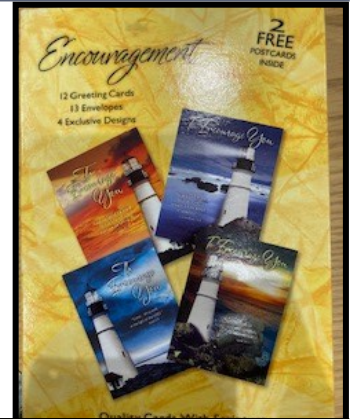
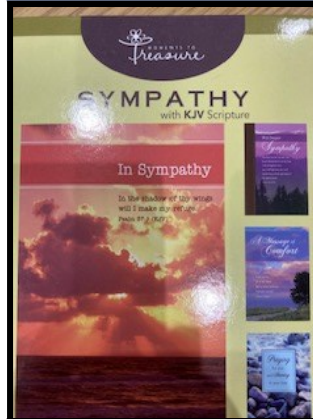

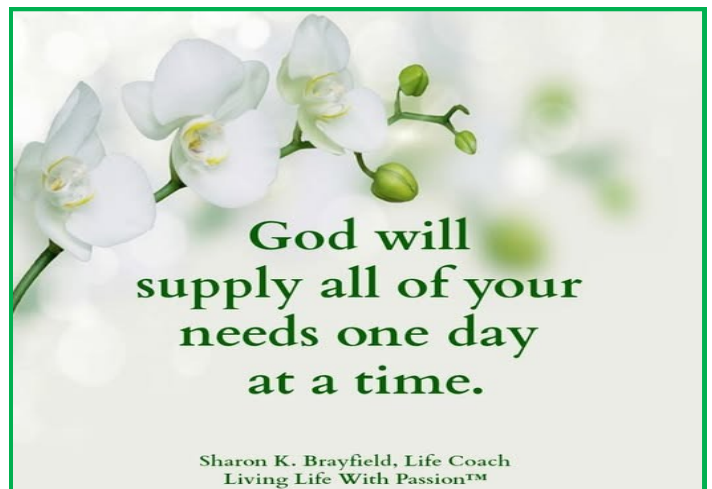
Hi, I just want to say a big special thanks to the persons who are watering the plants in front of the Church during the week.
