
Lining up for a delicious Breakfast


Feb. 13, we served just over 90 plates of sausage, pancakes with all the trimmings.

"No!" the children answered.


"If I cleaned the church every day, mowed the Yard, and kept everything neat and tidy, would that get me into Heaven?"


Building Our Sanctuary

Dill Pickle Chicken Salad

Ingredients:

2 cups cooked chicken, shredded or diced

1 cup dill pickle, diced

1/2 cup celery, diced

1/4 cup red onion, finely diced

1/4 cup green onion, thinly sliced

1 tablespoon dill

1/4 cup mayonnaise

1/4 cup sour cream

1 tablespoon pickle juice

1 tablespoon Dijon mustard

Salt and pepper to taste

Directions:

- 1. Mix the chicken, dill pickle, celery, red and green onion, and dill
- 2. Mix mayonnaise, sour cream, pickle juice, mustard, salt and pepper.
- Toss the salad and the dressing until coated and enjoy right away or chill in the fridge from an hour to overnight.

This is a good way to use up left over rotisserie chicken. Makes a great sandwich in a croissant.
