Pastor Boyd's Recipe Corner

Here is a favorite recipe of Jacqueline and I. Enjoy!

Boyd's Greek Potatoes (multiply recipe to feed more people)

Ingredients:

- 2 1/3 cup olive oil
- 2 1/2 cup water.
- 2 4 cloves garlic, crushed or finely chopped
- 2 1/3 cup fresh lemon juice
- ② 2 tsp oregano (my favorite) or 1 teaspoon dried thyme and 1 teaspoon dried rosemary as per the original recipe.
- 2 cubes chicken bouillon or equivalent liquid Chicken stock syrup
- Pepper to taste
- ☑ Salt dust final product with salt to taste
- ② 6 potatoes, peeled and cubed in 1 to 1.5 inch pieces. Use yellow potatoes as they don't turn to mush when cooked.

Directions:

- 1. Pre-cook potatoes alone until they are done. Pour off cooking water when potatoes are done.
- 2. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).
- 3. Dissolve 2 cubes chicken stock into ½ cup of hot water to make a concentrated stock.
- 4. In a small bowl, mix olive oil, chicken stock, garlic, lemon juice, oregano, and pepper.
- 5. Pour all ingredients over potatoes and turn them until potatoes are well coated.
- 6. Spread everything into a pyrex cake pan and bake at 350 degrees until water is evaporated and remaining sauce is slightly thickened. Then turn oven to 385 and bake until browned. Turn potatoes periodically to make sure all potatoes are well coated with resulting sauce.
- 7. Salt and pepper to taste, and serve.





Men's Breakfast for January 13 was cancelled due to the cold weather. Hope to see you for the February Men's Breakfast on February 10.




We are so happy to see a few new children in the class, praying that God will continue to bless the children and our church.


From The Mouths Of Babes!

The addition to the old church was dedicated in August of 1980.

In <u>March of 1990</u>, Pastor Glen stopped by the building of a new Senior Lodge in Stony Plain, and asked if he could get some of the toilets from the old building that was being removed. They told him he could have the whole building with the toilets for free, but the moving would cost \$8000.00. He presented this to the Council and Congregation and with many prayers and an overwhelming response raised \$12,000.00 within a week for moving and setting up the **Prayer and Retreat Center**.
